#### **EXPLANATION OF CHARGES**

#### PAYMENT AND OTHER INFORMATION

Payment Due Date - Your bill is due when you receive it. Your bill becomes delinquent after the due date if not paid. If you do not pay all charges by the due date, TID may shut off your electric service after giving you proper notice. When mailing a payment, allow 5 to 7 business days for your payment to reach our office and be posted to your account. Payments made by phone, at an authorized TID pay station or on-line from the TID website will be posted to your account the following business day.

Payment Arrangements - If you cannot pay your balance in full, TID will consider financial arrangements based on individual circumstances. At your request, TID can provide information about possible sources of financial assistance for residential customers who cannot pay their bills. If you have questions or would like to discuss payment arrangements, please call (209) 883-8222 BEFORE the due date shown on your bill.

Disputed Bill Procedure - To receive answers to questions you have about this bill, please contact the TID Customer Service Division at 333 E. Canal Drive, Turlock, or call 883-8222 or 892-4953 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. District offices are closed on weekends and holidays. If, after conferring with a Customer Service Representative, you still believe your bill is in error, you may contact the TID Customer Service Department Manager, who will then review your bill. The decision of the Customer Service Department Manager may be appealed within five days to the TID Board of Directors for a final determination. All appeals, except those from customers receiving service on a Domestic Energy rate schedule, must include a deposit in the amount of the disputed bill.

**Delinquent Charge** - A delinquent charge of \$3.00 plus 1.5% of the prior balance is added to your account if payment is not received by the due date.

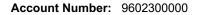
**Disconnect for Nonpayment** - Your service is subject to disconnect if we do not receive payment. If service is disconnected, a payment of the past due balance must be received by 4:00 p.m. workdays before service will be restored. Your account will be billed disconnect and reconnect charges, a security deposit (if required) and any other applicable charges. Service will not be restored after business hours, weekends or holidays. Receipt of payment on a service that has been disconnected for non-payment will be considered authorization to restore your electric service.

**Deposit** - A deposit or additional deposit may be required if bills are not paid on time, or if a service is scheduled to be disconnected for non-payment. An additional deposit may also be required if actual usage is higher than what was used to establish the deposit on hand.

Dear Mr. Hobbs:

This letter is in follow-up to the April 9, 2020 and December 1, 2020 correspondence from Kern County Water Agency ("Agency") to Western Hills Water District ("WHWD"), as well as our subsequent discussions regarding WHWD's default under the Contract to Transfer Water between the Agency and WHWD dated June 5, 2000 ("Contract"), and specifically the outstanding and long-overdue funds owed to the Agency under the Contract.

In light of WHWD's uncured default, the Agency simply is not in a position to continue supplying water without adjustments, particularly as WHWD has not made any payments at all to the Agency since July 1, 2019. In the meantime, WHWD's principal debt to the Agency continues to increase, along with interest. Based upon the information we have received to date regarding WHWD's financial condition and its continuing disputes with funding source Angel's Crossing, LLC, it appears to be very unlikely that WHWD will begin paying down its debt to the Agency in the near future.

As a result, the Agency must take measures to mitigate its losses and reduce WHWD's accumulation of additional debt, pursuant to the Agency's rights under Article 5 of the Contract. Article 5 provides, in relevant part:

In the event of any default by Western Hills in the payment of any money required to be paid to the Agency hereunder, or in any other obligations under this Agreement, the Agency in its discretion may suspend delivery of water to Western Hills during the period when Western Hills is delinquent in its payment for or obligations due to the Agency under the terms of this Agreement; provided, that (1) the Agency has given Western Hills not less than four months' prior, written notice of any such default and provided Western Hills a reasonable time to cure such default, and (2) during any such period of delinquency or suspension Western Hills shall remain obligated to make all payments required under this Agreement.

The Agency provided such written notice to WHWD on April 9, 2020. At this time, over a year later, WHWD remains in uncured default.

Nonetheless, because WHWD has represented to the Agency that it is currently making good-faith efforts to generate additional funds for the purpose of paying down its debt to the Agency, the Agency is willing to provide a reasonable opportunity for WHWD to do so. Accordingly, rather than suspend water deliveries in their entirety, at this time the Agency will continue to supply WHWD 250 acre feet per year through December 31, 2022. However, the Agency reserves the right to impose further water limitations at any time (including prior to December 31, 2022), while WHWD remains in uncured default.

This amount is based upon WHWD's representation that its annual projected residential water demand is 250 acre feet. Our hope and expectation is that the reduction in WHWD's water expenses as a result of this measure will allow WHWD to focus its efforts on generating funds to repay the debt owed to the Agency.

Further, and based upon WHWD's representations that it is making best efforts to generate funds to pay its debt to the Agency, the Agency is willing to hold off on litigation to collect the amounts due and owing under the Contract, in exchange for a reasonable tolling agreement extension. Accordingly, the Agency proposes that the parties extend their existing tolling agreement for a period of one year, provided that either party has the right to commence litigation after providing written notice of such intention at least 60 days in advance. Please contact me to confirm that WHWD is amenable to this proposal, and we will prepare a proposed extension agreement.

The Agency does not waive any of its rights, claims or defenses at law or in equity, and the Agency explicitly reserves all rights, claims and defenses, including but not limited to its right to seek full damages and/or equitable relief as a result of WHWD's default.

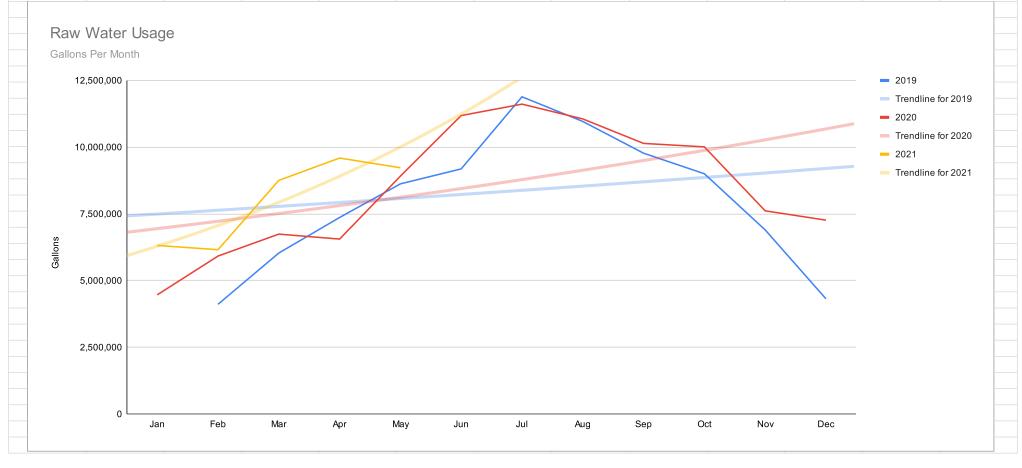

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2021-1**

## AN ORDINANCE DECLARING WATER SHORTAGE AND IMPLEMENTATION OF WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

WHEREAS, the Department of Water Resources, the operator of the State Water Project from which WHWD ultimately derives its water supplies, has declared that currently there will be a five percent ("5%") Table "A" Water Allotment for 2021; and

WHEREAS, due to the ongoing contractual dispute between WHWD and the Kern County Water Agency ("KCWA"), KCWA is limiting water deliveries to WHWD in the amount of 250 acre feet per year through December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Water Code §375, et seq., the District is enabled to implement conservation measures and enforcement proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Western Hills Water District Board of Directors, as set forth in detail below, find that there is a pending and urgent water shortage, and it is in the best interests of the District and its customers to implement the measures as set forth herein.

The Board of Directors of the Western Hills Water District does hereby ordain as follows:

- 1. Based upon present conditions, California is in a state of drought.
- 2. Given the current SWP Table "A" Allotment and KCWA's determination that it will limit WHWD water deliveries to 250 acre feet per year through December 31, 2022 there is a significant likelihood that water demands in the District cannot be met.
- 3. It is hereby determined that present conditions compromise the District's ability to supply raw water and/or treated water to its customers.
- 4. Based on current information, it is imperative that the District seek to reduce water usage by at least 25%.
- 5. Due to these conditions, the following Water Conservation Measures are hereby implemented:
- A. All Meters (1" & 2") will be monitored and water usage tracked to ensure a 25% reduction in use.
- B. Water shall be confined to the customer's property and shall not be allowed to runoff to adjoining properties or to the roadside ditch or gutter. Care shall be taken not to water

past the point of saturation.

- C. Free-flowing hoses for all uses are prohibited. Automatic shut-off devices shall be attached on any hose or filling apparatus in use.
- D. Leaking customer pipes or faulty sprinklers shall be repaired within two (2) working days or less if warranted by the severity of the problem.
- E. All pools, spas, and ornamental fountains/ponds shall be equipped with a recirculation pump and shall be constructed to be leak-proof. Pool draining and refilling shall be allowed only for health, maintenance, or structural considerations.
- F. Irrigation of public and private landscaping is only permitted on Tuesdays and Thursdays and only between the hours of 12am and 8am.
- G. Installation of new turf is prohibited. (All new developments as well as HOA and non-HOA maintained homes must use Drought Resistant landscaping moving forward.) HOA maintained homes that remove turf, must replace with drought resistance landscaping).
  - H. Washing cars is prohibited.
  - I. No water may be used for cleaning or rinsing equipment, trailers, or boats.
- J. Washing streets, parking lots, driveways, sidewalks, or buildings, except as necessary for health or sanitary purposes, is prohibited.
- K. Water for flow testing and construction purposes from water agency fire hydrants and blow-offs is prohibited.
- L. Flushing of sewers or fire hydrants is prohibited except in case of emergency and for essential operations.
- M. The "wasteful and unnecessary" use of water is prohibited, including but not limited to:
- i. Allowing flow from an unattended hose, except cooling/heating/similar device discharges;
- ii. Hand watering a lawn if it is also watered by other means, except for spot treatment;
- iii. Hosing-down a driveway or other impervious surface instead of a broom to remove debris.

- 6. Strict enforcement of the Water Conservation Measures set forth herein shall occur in accordance with the Western Hills Water District's Water Conservation Measures Ordinance No. 2020-1, adopted herewith.
- 7. The officers, employees and agents of the District are hereby authorized and directed, jointly and severally, to execute and deliver any and all documents and agreements and to do any and all things which they may deem necessary or advisable in order to carry out and comply with the terms of this Ordinance.
- 8. This Ordinance shall be published by one insertion in the *Patterson Irrigator*, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Patterson, within ten (10) days after its passage, and shall take effect immediately, in accordance with Water Code §376.
