As a preface to the letter recently received from Senator Marie Alvarado-Gil, I would like to offer the following context. While Senator Alvarado-Gil's remarks reflect certain historical elements, it's important to recognize that much of what she referenced pertains to a period when the Western Hills Water District (WHWD) was under the control of its former owner, World International (WI). That chapter in our history is precisely why WHWD is actively pursuing legal action against WI for alleged breach of contract, fraud, and the misappropriation of public funds.

I want to express my sincere appreciation for your continued outreach to State agencies and elected representatives. It is clear that your engagement has played a role in prompting Senator Alvarado-Gil's attention to our situation.

I would also like to publicly recognize and commend both Supervisor Channce Condit and Assemblymember Juan Alanis for their steadfast support. Their professionalism and genuine concern for our Community have been evident throughout, and I encourage you to extend your appreciation to them as well.

Please remember that every official and agency operates within certain limitations of authority. However, that does not diminish the effort and commitment many are showing on our behalf.
