



WHWD Clubhouse: Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: How do I book the Clubhouse?

A: Use of the facility requires a three-step process:

1. Contact the WHWD Clubhouse Coordinator for a site visit.
2. Submit a formal Request for Information (RFI).
3. Obtain final approval from the WHWD Board of Directors.

Q: Can I have beer, wine, or champagne at my event?

A: No. The WHWD Clubhouse is a strictly alcohol-free facility. This policy applies to the building, the parking lot, and all District grounds. Violation of this rule results in immediate event termination and forfeiture of your security deposit.

Q: Are pets allowed inside?

A: No. Only ADA-defined Service Animals are permitted. Emotional support animals and pets are not allowed.

Q: Does my service animal need to be on a leash?

A: Yes. For the safety of the animal, our guests, and local wildlife, all service animals must always remain on a physical leash while on the property.

Q: What are the Diablo Grande HOA rules I should know?

A: Because we are located within a private HOA, guests must adhere to:

- Noise Ordinances: Sound must be kept at a reasonable level; no loud outdoor music.
- Parking: Vehicles must park in designated spaces only; no blocking of residential driveways.
- Wildlife: We are a "Leave No Trace" facility. Do not feed, approach, or disturb the wildlife. All trash must be removed from the site by the applicant.

Q: Is there a fee to use the facility?

A: Yes. There is a refundable security deposit of \$500.00. The current rental rate for the property is \$900.00 not including the security deposit.
