

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-01**

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE  
WESTERN HILLS WATER DISTRICT ADOPTING  
REVISED COMMERCIAL WATER CHARGE RATE**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Board (the “Board”) of the Western Hills Water District (the “District”) is authorized to establish and adjust rates for water services provided by the District pursuant to applicable provisions of the California Water Code and other relevant laws;

**WHEREAS**, the Board has reviewed the current commercial water charge rates and determined that adjustments are necessary to promote efficient water use, reflect operational costs, and provide tiered pricing that encourages conservation among commercial users; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that these revised rates will lower the overall cost structure for commercial users while maintaining the financial stability of the District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Board of the Western Hills Water District does hereby resolve:**

**SECTION 1. Incorporation of Recitals.**

The Board finds and determines that the above-referenced recitals and findings are true and correct and material to this Resolution.

**SECTION 2. Board Actions.**

The Board hereby takes the following actions:

The Board hereby adopts the revised commercial water charge rates, as follows:

- Tier 1, \$6 per 1,000 gallons up to 5,000 gallons;
- Tier 2, \$8 per 1,000 gallons from 5,001 to 10,000 gallons; and
- Tier 3, \$10 per 1,000 gallons from 10,001 gallons and over.

These rates shall become effective immediately upon adoption or as otherwise provided by law.
